

Anthurium



Flower

Out of flower

Description: the bract (spatha) changes colour (not natural discolouration) and/or loses its gloss. The spadix turns brown.

Reject: if more than 25% of the bract has changed colour
or if more than 50% of the spadix has turned brown and the bract is also partially discoloured
or if more than 50% of the spadix is brown and desiccated
or if the spadix has dropped off.
Not to be rejected on the basis of a brown spadix alone. Not to be rejected on the basis of natural discolouration of the bract alone.

Record: if more than 50% of the spadix is brown.

Wilting flower

Description: the bract is wilting.

Reject: when the bract is visually wilting.

Discolouration

Record: natural discolouration of the bract.
