

Brassica

Foliage

Wilting

Description: the foliage has visibly wilted.

Reject: if more than 50% of the foliage has wilted.

Leaf margins/leaf spots/leaf desiccation

Description: the margins of the leaves change colour and may dry out and/or spots appear in the leaves that may

dry out and/or the leaf dries out and turns grey/brown.

Reject: if more than 50% of the leaf area and/or 50% of the total number of leaves is affected by this

phenomenon.

Leaf abscission

Description: the leaves fall from the stem.

Reject: if more than 50% of the total number of leaves have fallen from the stem.

Yellow leaves

Description: the leaves turn yellow.

Reject: if more than 50% of the overall leaf area and/or 50% of the total number of leaves have turned yellow.

Stem

Slimy stems

Description: the stem turns slimy.

Record: all cases.

Reject: if the stem is collapsing.
