
Evaluation card Rosa

Flower

Bent neck

Description: the drying and kinking of the stem just below the bud.

Write-off: when the flower is at an angle greater than 90° (see figure).



Botrytis

Description: light damage: visible pox on the petals.

Heavy infestation: Brown spots of 1 cm or larger on the petals and/or disintegration

of the flower (or receptacle) and/or the receptacle is seriously affected.

Write-off: if five or more petals suffer from severe damage and/or the receptacle is severely

compromised.

Brown flower

Description: the petals are clearly turning brown, not as a result of Botrytis.

Write-off: if more than 5 petals are clearly (which is more than half) brown.

Flower desiccation

Description: the flower withers without blooming or turns yellow.

Write-off: upon detection.

Write off: spray roses: if more than 50% of the total number of flowers present exhibits this

phenomenon.

End of flowering

Description: the rose has fully opened (stage 4 and 5), the petals are falling off and/or

discoloring.

Write-off: if more than two petals have fallen off or if the flower is visibly limp. Writing off

cannot be done based on discoloration alone.

Write-off: spray roses: if more than 50% of the flowers have bloomed.

Flower edges

Description: the edges of the petals turn brown or black and may wither or brown spots may

appear on the outside of the petals (in red cultivars).

Write-off: if five or more petals are severely affected (i.e. more than 1 cm) by any of these

symptoms.

Withering

Description: the flower is visibly limp (hanging limply or the petals become wrinkled).

Write-off: upon detection.

Bud opening

Register: the extent to which the flower bud develops during the vase life. Form loss is also

registered (such as cup shape).

There are five stages:



firm pointed bud



2 loose pointed but, cilindrical



3 halt-open flower



4 ocen flower



5 maximally opened flower, heart is visible

The following applies for spray roses:

Stage 1: Most of the buds from the stem are in stage 1 Stage 2: Most of the buds from the stem are in stage 2 Stage 3: Most of the buds from the stem are in stage 3 Stage 4: Most of the buds from the stem are in stage 4 Stage 5: Most of the buds from the stem are in stage 5

Cup shape



Description: see photo.
Register: upon detection.

Bud desiccation

Description: the buds wither and/or turn yellow.
Register: the extent of bud desiccation.

Discoloration

Register: the petals turn blue or pale in color.

Stem

Kinking

Description: the stem kinks. Write-off: upon detection.

Botrytis

Description: the stem discolors gray to black, sometimes gray fluffy mold appears, part of the

stem above the affected area withers and the flower withers.

Write-off: upon detection.

Damage

Register: the stem changes color, discolors, or withers.

Foliage

Leaf shedding (abscission)

Description: the leaves fall from the stem.

Write-off: if more than 50% of the total number of leaves has fallen from the stem.

Leaf burning and/or desiccation Description: the leaves wither.

Write-off: if more than 50% of the total leaf surface area and/or 50% of the total number of

leaves have reached at least the stage in the photo.



Yellow and/or brown foliage

Description: the leaves turn yellow and/or brown.

Write-off: if more than 50% of the total leaf surface area and/or 50% of the total number

of leaves is affected by this phenomenon (see photo).



Limp foliage

Description: the leaves (of the compound leaf) are limp and/or the entire leaf is limp.

Write-off: if more than 50% of the number of flowers is limp.

Leaf spots

Description: the leaves have brown/black spots.

Write-off: if more than 50% of the total leaf surface area and/or 50% of the total number of

leaves is affected by this phenomenon (see photo).
