

Syringa

Flower

End of flowering

Description: flowers shrink and/or are shed and/or get brown and/or wilt.

Discard: shrinking, shedding or wilting: if more than 50% of the total number of flowers have shrunk, have been shed or have wilted, or if more than 25% of the total number of flowers has coloured brown.



Examples of branches discarded for brown flowers.

Flowering percentage

Register: the flowering percentage is the ratio between the number of opened buds and the total number of buds. This is estimated before the branch is discarded.

Leaf

Yellow, brown or withered leaf

Description: the leaf turns yellow and/or brown and/or withers.

Register: if this phenomenon occurs.
